CONSTRUCTION: SEWING

CONSTRUCTION: LEVEL OF INTRICACY

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The outfit is complex and layered, using multiple pieces to create a finished look. ➤ More than 50% of the main garment is hand-embellished ➤ All trim, embellishments, and accessories are created on site. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The outfit uses several (approximately 3-4) pieces to create a finished look. ➤ More than 25% (but less than 50%) of the main garment is hand-embellished. ➤ Most of the trim, embellishments, and accessories are created on site. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The outfit uses 2 (or less) pieces to create a finished look. ➤ Less than 25% of the main garment is hand-embellished. ➤ Most of the trim and embellishments are <u>not</u> created on site, but are created by the team. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The outfit is comprised of only 1 piece. ➤ None of the main garment is hand-embellished. ➤ None of the trim or embellishments are created on site. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There is a pile of cloth that doesn't resemble clothing at all.

HAND-SEWING

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The entire ensemble (garments, accessories, etc.) is completely hand-sewn. ➤ No sewing machine was used in any aspect of construction. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ More than 50% of the visible seams (garments, accessories, etc.) are hand-sewn. ➤ A sewing machine was used on some aspects of internal construction. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Some of the garment (but less than 50%) of the ensemble (garment, accessories, etc.) is hand-sewn. ➤ A sewing machine was used for most of the construction. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Most/all of the garment was constructed using a machine. ➤ Some hand-stitching may be used for embellishment/decorative purposes, but all functional seams were created using a machine.
